* **The Leadership Progression** is defined as a minimum of four semesters participation in the Corps, including participation in the New Cadet System; satisfactory completion of at least two Corps leadership positions, and having passed an ROTC or Corps Physical Fitness test (or alternate test in case of physical disability) at least once during a cadet career. Corps leadership positions which satisfy this requirement are those which have direct supervisory responsibility over other cadets and include Team Leader, Cadre Corporal, Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, First Sergeant, Battalion and Regimental Sergeants Major, Platoon Leader, Company, Battalion, and Regimental Executive Officer, any command position, and selected Battalion and regimental Staff positions which have supervisory responsibility over other cadets.
